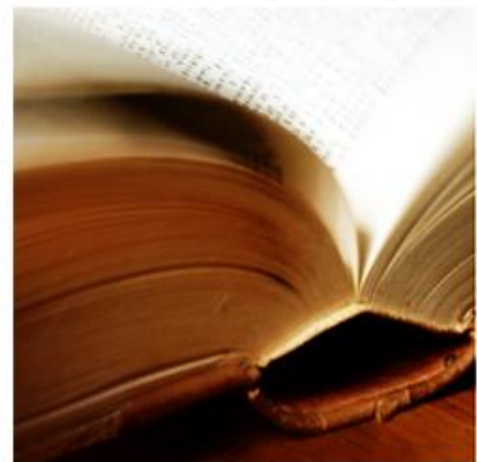

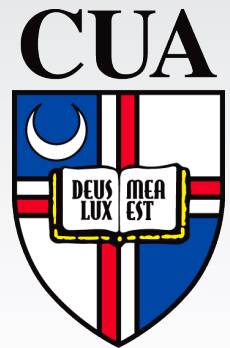

- Become part of discovery and the creation of knowledge



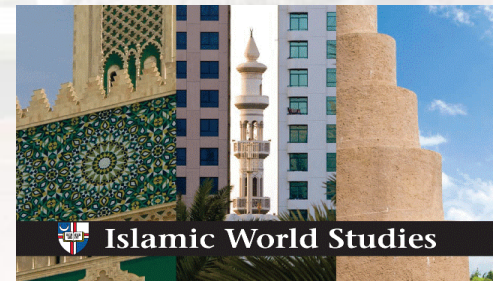
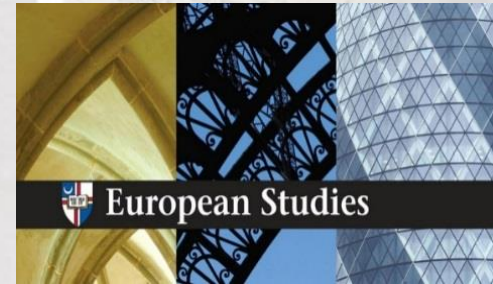
